Strengthened coconut seedlings development by developing elite natural tall coconut hybrids was inaugurated and the first seedling was planted by Dr.N.Kumar, Vice-Chancellor, TNAU, Coimbatore followed by Dr.K.Eraivan Arutkani Aiyanathan, Dean and other staff members of AC&RI, Killikulam. This research programme was initiated at this college to develop more vigorous elite natural tall coconut hybrids for commercial cultivation by planting 10 selected talls available from Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Kerala and allowing them for panmixis in isolation. Through this elite coconut plantation, elite natural T x T hybrid seedlings can be produced and supplied to the farmers. This is a pioneering attempt in coconut carried out for the first time in Asia.

Awards Obtained

TNAU bagged the Award for Excellence in Mushroom Research

The ICAR - All India Coordinated Research Project on Mushroom is functioning at the Department of Plant Pathology, TNAU, Coimbatore since 1983. Various research activities including collection and development of mushroom varieties of oyster, milky, butter



and medicinal mushrooms are being conducted. TNAU is also imparting training programmes on mushroom cultivation to farmers, woman self help groups, educated youths for developing entrepreneurship. Recognizing the significant achievements, TNAU has been awarded with Overall Outstanding Contribution Award at National Level by the Directorate of Mushroom Research, Solan of ICAR at the Annual workshop held online during 6-7th August, 2021. 
