E-YUVA centre functioning at Department of Plant Biotechnology, CPMB&B organized a webinar entitled 'Purifications made Simple and Flexible' on 26.07.2021. Mr.J.Sakthisaravanan, Product Manager – Drug discovery Solutions, Spinco Biotech Private Limited, Bengaluru handled the session. Final year undergraduate, second year postgraduate and doctoral students of CPMB&B attended the webinar. The webinar dealt with chromatography in general and HPLC in particular. The overall process involved in isolation and purification of natural compounds including the basics of chromatography and different types of liquid chromatography on the basis of scale of operation were discussed. The webinar mainly focused on preparative HPLC. A typical preparative HPLC setup was explained and a convenient system for upscaling was suggested. The webinar provided an insight on various chromatographic methods for purifying different compounds of interest. All the possible problems that would be encountered in HPLC experiments were enlisted and the trouble shooting mechanisms were discussed.
