<u>SMS Advisory:</u>

The weather will be dry, hot without any rain in the forth coming five days. Weather Based Agro-Advisories

Imp. Crop: Cotton, Maize, Onion, Sugarcane and Vegetables

Stage: Cotton- Maturation stage, Maize- Harvesting stage, Onion- Vegetative stage

- Since there is no rainfall for the coming five days harvesting of matured crops can be planned.
- Depending upon local weather, irrigation can be plan for garden land crops.
- The root zone of horticulture crops should covered with coir pith to conserve moisture.
- To control White fly and Jassids in cotton with Spray Imidacloprid 17.8 % @ 5 ml or • Thiomethoxam 6 g in 10 litres of water.
- To prevent early shedding of buds and squares in cotton spray 40ppm NAA (40mg of ٠ Naphthalene Acetic Acid in 1lit of water) at 60 and 90 DAS on the crops.
- In chillies to manage fruit borers set up pheromone traps @ 5/acre to attract adult moths.
