

AAS Bulletin for Nilgiris district issued by HRS, TNAU, Ooty and IMD, New Delhi for the period from 20.02.2016 to 24.02.2016

ISSUED ON 19.02.2016

Past weather:

- 1. Light rainfall in the district** – During the last three days no rain fall was received in the district.
- 2. Temperature and RH variation** - The maximum and minimum temperatures were 20°C - 21°C and 7-9° C respectively. Morning and afternoon relative humidity ranged between 66-85% and 67-82% in the past three days. Wind speed was 9-24 kmph during the last three days.

Agro meteorological advisory for Nilgiris district

1. No rainfall is expected in the district for the next five days.
2. To prevent Red Spider Mite attack in Tea field during summer, Silver Oak trees can be kept as such up to May for shade and can be pruned after May.
3. To prevent rubberisation disorder in Garlic, avoid Urea and use ammonium sulphate for nitrogen nutrition.
4. In summer to control coffee berry borer, avoid gleanings, destroy gleanings if any and carry out through harvest.
5. Growers are advised to Spray Neem oil (1% Azadirachtin) or Propargite 57% EC or Profenofos 50% EC or Dicofol 18.5% EC @ 2 ml / lr of water to control mites in Tea crop
