Weather Summary for the period since the issue of last bulletin 049(17.06.2016) for Tamil Nadu.

Maximum temperature ranged from 31°C to 38°C and minimum temperature ranged from 22°C to 30°C did prevail over the State. Kodaikanal and Uthagamandalam recorded maximum temperature ranged from 16°C to 20°C and minimum temperature ranged from 11°C to 13°C during the period. Isolated rainfall was recorded in Tamil Nadu.

Weather forecast for next five days: 22.06.2016 to 26.06.2016

According to district forecast issued by the India Meteorological Department for Coimbatore district, sky will be mostly cloudy. Light rainfall is expected during four days. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 32C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 22°C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 80 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 73 per cent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 20 km per hour and the wind direction will be from south direction.

Agro Advisory

- ✓ Since the cloud cover is more than 6 okta avoid soil application of nutrients to irrigated crops like turmeric, maize, cumbu and sorghum.
- ✓ Since the wind speed is more than 20 KMPH along with expected drizzling, propping may be given to matured banana crop against lodging.
- ✓ For monsoon crop of grapes, considering the prevailing weather pruning may be done followed by spraying of 1% Bordeaux mixture or any copper fungicide @ 0.25 percent.
- ✓ For jasmine, based on the prevailing weather manuring may be done @ 10 kg FYM and NPK at 60, 120 and 120 g/ plant.
- ✓ Considering the high relative humidity, before and after milking wash udder with 1% Potassium permanganate solution.
