Weather Summary for the period since the issue of last bulletin 051 (24.06.2016) for Tamil Nadu.

Maximum temperature ranged from 27°C to 34°C and minimum temperature ranged from 21°C to 28°C did prevail over the State. Kodaikanal and Uthagamandalam recorded maximum temperature ranged from 15°C to 18°C and minimum temperature ranged from 10°C to 12°C during the period. Isolated rainfall was recorded in Tamil Nadu.

Weather forecast for next five days: 29.06.2016 to 03.07.2016

According to district forecast issued by the India Meteorological Department for Coimbatore district, sky will be mostly cloudy. Light to moderate rainfall is expected during five days. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 32°C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 23°C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 82 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 59 per cent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 15 km per hour and the wind direction will be from south west direction.

Agro Advisory

- ✓ Considering the anticipated rainfall, Gypsum application @ 160kg/acre may be done in 40 days old rain fed groundnut of Pollachi taluk, followed by earthing up.
- ✓ Considering the anticipated rainfall drainage should be provided to kar paddy nursery to prevent rain damage to seedlings.
- ✓ Considering the anticipated rainfall and wind speed around 15 kmph, banana and sugarcane of 5 months old and above may be given with propping to avoid lodging.
- ✓ Considering the anticipated rainfall apply topdressing to 40 and 60 days old turmeric @ 22 kg urea, 72 kg Potash /acre.

SMS advisory

- ✓ Considering the anticipated rainfall drainage should be provided to kar paddy nursery to prevent rain damage to seedlings.
