Agro meteorological advisory for Nilgiris district

- ✓ Light rainfall is expected in the district in the next five days.
- ✓ Due to temperature fluctuation late blight in potato is fast spreading, to control, farmers are advised to spray Cymoxanil 8 % + Mancozeb 64 % @ 2 ml /lit of water.
- ✓ Due to continuous rain, carrot wilt disease is spreading in harvest stage crop. To control, drench the soil with Copper oxy chloride @ 1 gram per litre of water.
- ✓ To prevent disease incidence due to continuous rain, spray Pseudomonas @ 10 ml per litre of water.
- ✓ In pepper plantation, apply 200 grams Urea, 110 grams Super phosphate, 110 grams potash per vine during this monsoon season.
