Agro meteorological advisory for Nilgiris district

- ✓ Moderate to light rainfall is expected in the district in the next five days.
- ✓ In pepper plantation, apply 200 grams Urea, 110 grams Super phosphate, 110 grams potash per vine during this monsoon season.
- ✓ Since continuous rainfall is expected in Nilgiris for the next five days, make necessary drainage facilities in the field.
- ✓ While preparing the filed for cultivation, apply 12 tonnes of well decomposed Farm Yard Manure per acre.
- ✓ Chow chow can be planted in 45cm pits, 6 ft x 8 ft spacing. Plant 3 sprouted fruits per pit after filling with 10 kg compost, 250 g urea, 500 g super phosphate and 500 g potash.
