Agromet advisories in relation to the anticipated weather having high cloud cover and moderate humidity

Crop/ Farming system	Stage / Activities	Advisories
Cotton	Maturity stage	During this prevailing weather condition, pick the matured fully opened kapas in early morning and store properly.
Citrus	Fruiting stage	For controlling canker disease in citrus spray streptomycin sulphate 50 g and 150 g copper oxychloride / ha. Use 500 liter of water and spray using hand sprayer.
Orchard tree crops	Irrigation management	For the prevailing high wind speed, give irrigation to tree crops to protect from desiccation.
Orchard - New plantation crops	Field preparation	Wherever the farmers go for new plantation for orchard crops, dug a required size of pits at specific spacing and allow for aeration.
