Weather Advisory Bulletin – Cuddalore District (Period 18th to 22nd May 2016)

A. Weather for the past four days (13.05.2016 to 16.05.2016)

During past four days around Cuddalore district, the sky was mostly clear to mostly cloudy with 0.5mm of rainfall. Maximum temperature was 36.0-38.0°C and Minimum temperature was 27.0-28.0°C. Wind speed was 3-5 km per hour. Relative humidity was recorded between 61-100%. **B. Weather forecast for next five days (Until 08.30 hrs of 22.05.2016)**

Agrometeorological Advisories

- 1. Due to depression very heavy rainfall expected for next two days thereafter moderate rainfall for subsequent two days.
- 2. Farmers are advised to safe guard their animal from rain and chillness.
- 3. Farmers are advised to protect their feed ingredients from rainfall to avoid development of aflatoxin.
- 4. Farmers are advised to wash and clean the udder before milking and not to provide dusty roughage immediately after milking to avoid mastitis.

Imp. Crops: Rice, Sugarcane and Groundnut

- 1. Due to expected heavy rainfall farmers are advised not to apply fertilizer and pesticides to their crops.
- 2. Excess water in the crop field may be drained out.
