Weather Summary for the period since the issue of last bulletin 074(12.09.2016) for Tamil Nadu.

Maximum temperature ranged from 31°C to 38°C and minimum temperature ranged around 21°C to 28°C did prevail over the State. Kodaikanal and Uthagamandalam recorded maximum temperature ranged from 17°C to 20°C and minimum temperature ranged from 9°C to 12°C during the period. Isolated rainfall was recorded in Tamil Nadu.

Weather forecast for next five days: 17.09.2016 to 21.09.2016

According to district forecast issued by the India Meteorological Department for Coimbatore district, sky will be partly cloudy. Dry weather is expected. Maximum temperature is expected to be 30°C to 31°C and minimum temperature is expected to be 22°C to 23°C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be 75 to 78 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be 59 to 62 per cent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 14 km per hour and the wind direction will be from south direction.
