# AAS Bulletin for Nilgiris district issued by HRS, TNAU, Ooty and IMD, New Delhi for the period from 17.09.2016 to 21.09.2016

## **ISSUED ON 16.09.16**

### Past weather:

1. Rainfall in the district – During the last four days light rain fall was received in the district.

## 2. Temperature and RH variation:

The maximum and minimum temperatures were 17° - 20°C and 9°-11 ° C respectively. Morning and afternoon relative humidity ranged between 80-96% and **87%-94%** in the past three days. Wind speed was 20-35 kmph during the last three days.

### Agro meteorological advisory for Nilgiris district

- $\checkmark$  Light rainfall is expected in the district for tomorrow.
- ✓ Spray bionoculant Pseudomoans @ 10 ml per litre of water to prevent disease incidence in Horticultural crops.

- Due to temperature fluctuation, farmers are advised to spray Cymoxanil 8 % + Mancozeb 64 % @ 2 ml /lit to control late blight in potato.
- In potato crop, apply 50 kg Urea, 266 kg super phosphate and 40 kgs of potash at the time of sowing as basal and 30 days after sowing as top dressing.
- Head rot disease is fast spreading in Cabbage and Cauliflower. Farmers are advised to spray Copper Oxy Chloride @ 2g/l to control Head rot disease in Cabbage & Cauliflower.
- To control thrips infestation in Garlic, spray Dimethoate 1.5 ml per litre of water.
