# **ISSUED ON 31.01.17**

#### Past weather:

1. Rainfall in the district – During the last three days, light to heavy rain fall was received in the district.

## 2. Temperature and RH variation:

The maximum and minimum temperatures were 17°-18°C and 8°-11°C respectively. Morning and afternoon relative humidity ranged between 72-92% and 60-90% in the past three days. Wind speed was 4-7 kmph during the last three days.

## Agro meteorological advisory for Nilgiris district

- $\checkmark$  No rainfall is expected in the district for next five days.
- ✓ To preserve soil moisture, apply mulching in the soil around the plants. Necessary irrigation may be given to the plants.
- ✓ For Well grown mandarin orange trees, apply agricultural lime or Dolomite at 4 kg / tree during this month.

- $\checkmark$  In hill horticultural crops, installation of drip irrigation could save up to 50% water requirement of crop.
- ✓ While applying dolomite for all crops, dolamite should not be mixed with other chemical fertilizers.
- ✓ In summer to control coffee berry borer, avoid gleanings, destroy gleanings if any and carry out through harvest without leaving any berries in the plants.
