Weather Summary for the period since the issue of last bulletin 050(23.06.2017) for Tamil Nadu.

Maximum temperature ranged from 29°C to 40°C and minimum temperature ranged around 22°C to 30°C did prevail over the State. Kodaikanal and Uthagamandalam recorded maximum temperature ranged from 17°C to 22°C and minimum temperature ranged from 11°C to 13°C during the period. Isolated rainfall was recorded in Tamil Nadu.

Weather forecast for next five days: 28.06.2017 to 02.07.2017

According to district forecast issued by the India Meteorological Department for Coimbatore district, sky will be mostly cloudy. Dry weather or light drizzling for next five days. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 26°C to 28°C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 18°C to 19°C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 75 to 80 per cent and evening relative humidity is expected to be 50 to 55 per cent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 14 to 16 km per hour and the wind direction will be from south direction.

Agro Advisory

- ✓ Heavy wind (>16 km/hr) is anticipated. Hence, early season sugarcane and five months old banana crops may be propped against lodging.
- ✓ De-trashing or remove dry cane leaves to avoid borer infestation in early season planted cane of 150 days old.
- ✓ Considering the anticipated rainfall apply topdressing to 40 and 60 days old turmeric @ 22 kg urea, 72 kg Potash /acre.
- ✓ Dry weather or light drizzling is expected for next 5 days. By utilizing received rainfall, apply fertilizer for coconut @ 650 gm urea, 1kg SuPo₄, 1kg MOP and 2kg Neem cake along with 50kg FYM.
- ✓ Considering the prevailing weather, root feeding of TNAU coconut tonic 200ml/ tree is advised for arresting button shedding in coconut.
