

**AAS Bulletin for Nilgiris district issued by Horticultural Research Station, TNAU, Ooty  
and Indian Meteorological Department, New Delhi for the period from  
28.06.2017 to 02.07.2017**

**ISSUED ON 27.06.2017**

**Past weather:**

**1. Rainfall in the district** – During the last four days, light rainfall was received in some parts of the district.

**2. Temperature and Relative Humidity variation:**

The maximum and minimum temperatures were 17°C - 22°C and 11°C - 12°C respectively. Morning and afternoon relative humidity ranged between 75 - 88 % and 82 - 96 % respectively. Wind speed was 14 - 17 kmph during the last four days.

- ✓ Due to cloudy weather, there may be chances for the spread of fungal diseases in hilly vegetable crops. Farmers are advised to adopt prophylactic fungicide spray to control fungal diseases.
