Weather Based Agro-Advisories: Important Crops: Chilly & (Animal husbandry)

Prevailing weather conditions the incenses of Die-back and fruit rot in Chilly. Farmers are advised to spray Mancozeb 2 g/lit or Copper oxychloride 2.5 g/lit thrice at 15 days interval starting from noticing the die-back symptoms.

Due to prevailing weather condition, cattle are affected with tiredness, so the cattle rearers are advised to feed the mineral mixture to calf, and also deworm your calf as per schedule.
