Weather Based Agro-Advisories : Important Crops : Tomato & (Animal husbandry)

Prevailing weather conditions the incense of early leaf blight disease is predominant in tomato growing areas. For the management of this disease, remove and destroy the infected crop debris. Spray the crop with mancozeb 2g/ lit or chlorothalonil 2g/ lit at fortnight intervals for effective disease control.

Due to prevailing weather condition, cattle are affected with tiredness, so the cattle rearers are advised to feed the mineral mixture to calf, and also deworm your calf as per schedule.
