



Agro Meteorological Advisory Services (AAS) Bulletin for Nilgiris district issued by Horticultural Research Station, TNAU, Ooty and India Meteorological Department, New Delhi for the period from 02.05.2018 to 06.05.2018

Past weather:

1. Rainfall in the district – During the last four days, moderate rainfall was received in the Nilgiris district.

2. Temperature and Relative Humidity variation:

The maximum and minimum temperatures were 24° C - 25° C and 11° C - 13° C respectively. Morning and afternoon relative humidity ranged between 52 - 66 % and 62 - 85% respectively. Wind speed was 7 - 10 kmph during the last four days.

- ✓ Moderate rainfall is expected in the Nilgiris district for next five days
- ✓ To maintain milk yield in milch animals, keep the animals cool by sprinkling water on milch animals during daytime in summer season. Azolla can be used as feed during summer season.
- ✓ Due to expected rainfall in the coming days, to prevent collar rot disease in beans, soil drenching with copper oxy chloride 1 g/lit of water may be followed.
