Weather forecast for next five days (23.04.2022 to 27.04.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Nagapattinam district, the sky will be moderately cloudy. Rainfall is expected on 23.04.2022 and 25.04.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 33 °C to 34 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 27 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 75 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 65 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 8 km per hour and the wind direction will be south east.

Green manure		Rising of green manure crops like daincha, sunnhemp and kolinji can be done by utilizing the forecasted rainfall.
Livestock	Cattle and Goat	Calves above 3 months and sheep and goat above 2 months should be vaccinated against Foot and Mouth disease
