Weather forecast for next five days (13.04.2022 to 17.04.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Tiruvarur district, the sky will be moderately cloudy. Rainfall is expected from 13.04.2022 to 15.04.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 34 °C to 37 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 26 °C to 27 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 75 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 60 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 8-10 km per hour and the wind direction will be east south east.

Crop	Stage	Advisory
Rice	Harvest	Farmers are advised to provide adequate drainage facilities after rain harvest the paddy crop and temporarily stored it in the raised area in the farm.
Pulses	Harvest	Harvest the matured blackgram and greengram plants.

Banana		Provide support with wooden poles to avoid lodging of tress.
Green manure		Raising of green manure crops like daincha, sunnhemp and kolinji can be done by utilizing the rainfall.
Cattle	Cow	The expected rain favours pneumonia in calves and kids and advised to prevent them by avoiding expose to rain water.
