Weather forecast for next five days (30.07.2022 to 03.08.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Nagapattinam district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. Rainfall is expected from 30.07.2022 to 03.08.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 33 °C to 34 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 25 °C to 27 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 80 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 50 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 8-9 km per hour and the wind direction will be west.
