Weather forecast for next five days (27.08.2022 to 31.08.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Perambalur district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. Rainfall is expected on 27.08.2022 to 31.08.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 33 °C to 34 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 23 °C to 25 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 80 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 60 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 6-12 km per hour and the wind direction will be west.

Crop	Stage	Advisory
General		Farmers are advised to provide adequate drainage facilities to all crops due to moderate to heavy rainfall forecast.
		Avoid application of fertilizers and insecticides to the crops.
Rice	Nursery	Due to moderate to heavy rainfall forecast, farmers are advised to provide adequate drainage facilities to the samba rice nursery to avoid seedling damage.
Banana		Provide support with wooden poles to avoid lodging of tree.
Cattle	Cow	Exposure of calves and kids to rain should be avoided to prevent from pneumonia attack in view of expected high rain.

SMS advisory

Due to moderate to heavy rainfall forecast, farmers are advised to provide adequate drainage facilities to the samba rice nursery to avoid seedling damage.
