Weather Summary and forecast for Perambalur district

Weather forecast for next five days (09.08.2022 to 13.08.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Perambalur district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. Rainfall is expected on 12.08.2022 and 13.08.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 34 °C to 35 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 25 °C to 26°C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 70 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 55 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 14 km per hour and the wind direction will be west south west.
