Weather forecast for next five days (03.08.2022 to 07.08.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Perambalur district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. Rainfall is expected on 03.08.2022 to 07.08.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 32 °C to 35 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 23 °C to 24 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 80 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 65 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 10-16 km per hour and the wind direction will be south.

Cattle	Cow	Exposure of calves and kids to rain should be avoided to prevent from pneumonia attack in view of expected high rain.
