Weather forecast for next five days (17.08.2022 to 21.08.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Perambalur district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. Rainfall is expected on 17.08.2022 to 19.08.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 33 °C to 35 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 25 °C to 26 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 70 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 60 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 6 km per hour and the wind direction will be south west.
