Weather forecast for next five days (06.08.2022 to 10.08.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Thanjavur district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. Rainfall is expected on 08.08.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 33 °C to 35 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 26 °C to 27 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 60 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 40 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 6-8 km per hour and the wind direction will be south west.
