According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Thanjavur district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. Rainfall is expected on 17.08.2022 and 19.08.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 34 °C to 35 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 25 °C to 26 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 75 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 65 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 8-10 km per hour and the wind direction will be south south west.
