Weather forecast for next five days (20.08.2022 to 24.08.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Tiruvarur district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. Rainfall is expected on 20.08.2022, 21.08.2022, 22.08.2022 and 24.08.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 35 °C to 37 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 25 °C to 26 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 80 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 60 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 10-12 km per hour and the wind direction will be west.
