→ Light rain is likely to occur on 09th, 12th and 13th July.

→ Thunderstorm with lightning is likely to occur at isolated places on 09th and 10th July.

☁ During next five days, the sky will be cloudy. The temperature range is expected to be around 27°C - 35°C. Relative humidity range is expected to be around 65-75%. The wind speed is expected to be 15-20 km per hour and the wind will be mostly from west direction.

☔ Rainfall (2.0 mm) will be below normal, maximum temperature (30.71°C) and minimum temperature (24.50°C) will be normal from 14th to 20th July.

Weather based Agro-Advisories.

Crop	Stage/Particulars	Agro Advisory
Sugarcane	Tillering phase	To control shoot borer in sugarcane, soil application of Cartaphydrochloride 4G 10 kg/hectare may be done.
Brinjal	Flowering Stage	To manage Brinjal shoot borer, apply neem cake 200 kg/ha or spray Emamectin Benzoate 4% SG@ 0.4 g/l.
Cassava	Vegetative stage	To control Red mite in cassava, apply Pongamia oil 500 ml/ha or spray Propargite 750 ml and Sulphur 1250 g/ ha.

SMS: Light rain is expected during next few days. Hence, farmers may postpone irrigation.
