#### Weather forecast for next five days (02.07.2022 to 06.07.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Perambalur district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. Rainfall is expected from 02.07.2022 to 04.07.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 36 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 26 °C to 27 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 70 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 50 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 10 km per hour and the wind direction will be west.

		weedicide applied field.		
R	ice	In <i>kuruvai</i> paddy one hand weeding is to be given on 20 to 25 days after transplanting.		
Cattle	Cow	Farmers are advised to provide sufficient mineral mixture to nourish the cattle health.
