Weather forecast for next five days (27.07.2022 to 31.07.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Perambalur district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. Rainfall is expected from 27.07.2022 to 31.07.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 34 °C to 36 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 24 °C to 26 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 70 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 40 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 5-7 km per hour and the wind direction will be south.
