Weather forecast for next five days (14.05.2022 to 18.05.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Ariyalur district, the sky will be clear. Rainfall is expected from 15.05.2022 and 17.05.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 31 °C to 32 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 24 °C to 26 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 85 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 70 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 8 km per hour and the wind direction will be west.

Crop	Stage	Advisory
General		Since light to moderate rainfall expected in the coming days, ploughing can be done to control weeds and larva of insects.

Green manure		Since slight rainfall expected in the coming days, raising of green manure crops like daincha, sunnhemp and kolinji can be done.
Irrigated Black gram	Vegetative stage	Since light to moderate rainfall expected in the coming days, irrigation can be postponed.
Livestock	Cattle and Goat	The rainy season favours pneumonia in calves and kids and prevent them by avoiding expose to rain water.
