SUGARCANE	To alleviate the micronutrient deficiency as well as to improve the yield of ration sugarcane, foliar spraying with sugarcane booster @ 1 kg / acre 45 days after planting, @1.5 kg / acre 60 days after planting and @ 2 kg / acre 75 days after planting in 200 liters of water along with sticking agent.
