Forecast for next five days: 05.11.2022 to 09.11.2022

- → Heavy rain is likely to occur at many places on 05<sup>th</sup> November.
- ▶ Light to moderate rain is likely to occur at many places from 06<sup>th</sup> to 09<sup>th</sup> November.
- → Heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places from 06<sup>th</sup> to 09<sup>th</sup> November.
- ▶ Thunderstorm with lightning is likely to occur at isolated places from 05<sup>th</sup> to 07<sup>th</sup> November.

During next five days, the sky will be cloudy. The temperature range is expected to be around 24-31°C. Relative humidity range is expected to be around 75-90%. The wind speed is expected to be 10-14 km per hour and the wind will be mostly from North North East direction.

Rice	Tillering stage	To manage rice <b>leaf folder</b> release <i>Trichogramma chilonis</i> 5cc (1,00,000/ha) at 37, 44, 51 days after planting. Avoid excess application of nitrogen fertilizers. Setup light trap to attract adult moths. Setup T- shaped bird perches for predatory birds to control these pests. Apply cartaphydrochloride 50% SP @ 2g/l or flubendiamide 20 WG @ 0.25 g/l or thiamethoxam 25 WG @ 0.2 g/l.
Cattle	Vaccination	Farmers are requested to do <b>Foot and Mouth Disease</b> vaccination for their livestock as the prevailing weather conditions are more conducive for Foot and Mouth Disease.

**SMS:** Provide adequate drainage to all crops as light to heavy rainfall is expected for next few days.
