- ▶ Light to moderate rain is likely to occur at many places from 29th October to 02nd November.
- Heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places on 30th, 31st October and 02nd November.
- Thunderstorm with lightning is likely to occur at isolated places from 29th October to 02nd November.

⁷ During next five days, the sky will be cloudy. The temperature range is expected to be around 22-31°C. Relative humidity range is expected to be around 60-90%. The wind speed is expected to be 10-12 km per hour and the wind will be mostly from North North East direction.

Rice	Tillering stage	 → To manage rice leaf folder release <i>Trichogramma chilonis</i> 5cc (1,00,000/ha) at 37, 44, 51 days after planting. → Avoid excess application of nitrogen fertilizers. → Setup light trap to attract adult moths. → Setup T- shaped bird perches for predatory birds to control these pests. Apply cartaphydrochloride 50% SP @ 2g/l or flubendiamide 20 WG @ 0.25 g/l or thiamethoxam 25 WG @ 0.2 g/l.
Cattle	Vaccination	Farmers are requested to do Foot and Mouth Disease vaccination for their livestock as the prevailing weather conditions are more conducive for Foot and Mouth Disease.

SMS: Provide adequate drainage to all crops as light to heavy rainfall is expected for next few days.
