Weather forecast for next five days (29.10.2022 to 02.11.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Ariyalur district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. Rainfall is expected on 30.10.2022 and 02.11.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 30 °C to 32 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 23 °C to 25 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 85 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 70 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 12-14 km per hour and the wind direction will be north.
