Weather forecast for next five days (26.10.2022 to 30.10.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Karur district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. Rainfall is expected on 30.10.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 31 °C to 33 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 20 °C to 21°C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 75 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 60 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 4 km per hour and the wind direction will be east north east.

Rice	Main field	The control the reduced crop growth in rice by the prevailing weather condition, apply 8.4 kg /ac Muriate of Potash as top dressing and 0.5% Zinc sulphate as foliar spray.
Rice		For Thaladi season, medium duration rice varieties like ADT 38, ADT 46, ADT 49, Improved white Ponni, IR 20, ASD 19, Paiyur1, TRY 1, TRY 3, Co 48, Co 49 and Co 50 varieties are suitable.
Cattle	Cow	Before monsoon ensure that cows and buffaloes were vaccinated against food and mouth disease.
