Weather forecast for next five days (29.10.2022 to 02.11.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Thanjavur district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. Rainfall is expected on 29.10.2022 to 02.11.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 29 °C to 33 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 24 °C to 25 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 85 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 70 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 10-12 km per hour and the wind direction will be north east.

General		Farmers are advised to provide adequate drainage facilities to all crops due to light to moderate rainfall forecast.
		Avoid application of fertilizers and insecticides to the crops.
		Due to light to moderate rainfall forecast, farmers are advised to Postpone irrigation to all crops.
Rice	Nursery	Due to light to moderate rainfall forecast, farmers are advised to provide adequate drainage facilities to the <i>Thaladi</i> rice nursery to avoid seedling damage.
Banana		Provide support with wooden poles to avoid lodging of tree.
Cattle	Cow	Exposure of calves and kids to rain should be avoided to prevent from pneumonia attack in view of expected high rain.
