Weather forecast for next five days (21.09.2022 to 25.09.2022)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Perambalur district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. Light rainfall is expected on 25.09.2022. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 35 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be around 25 °C to 26 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 70 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 55 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 6-8 km per hour and the wind direction will be west.
