Minimum Temperature: Minimum temperatures are likely to be generally near normal and are likely to be in the range 16°C to 24°C over the district during next week 03rd to 09th Feb 2023.

COTTON	The incense of Alternaria leaf blight in Cotton. This disease may occur in all stages but is more severe during 45-60 days of plant growth. Small pale to brown, irregular, or round spots may appear on the leaves. Sometimes stem lesions are also seen. In severe cases, the spots may appear on bracts and bolls. Remove and destroy the infected plant residues. Spray Copper oxychloride @ 2kg per hectare immediately after the occurrence of the disease. Two to three sprays may be given at 15-day intervals.

BRINJAL	The occurrence of root-knot nematodes and reniform nematodes was noticed in vegetable crops. The nematode-infested field shows day wilting symptoms and also galls in the root. Farmers are advised to apply neem cake @ 400kg/ha and intercrop with marigold and also apply Purpureocillium lilacinum @ 2½ kg/ha mixed with 100 kg of FYM.

GOAT	Farmers are advised to vaccinate their Goats for Goat Pox disease. The first dose is at the age of 3 to 6 months and the booster dose will be given once a year before the summer season.

GENERAL ADVICE	Since cloudy humid weather is prevailing, farmers are advised to use the yellow sticky trap @ 10-15/acre to monitor the incidence of sucking pests and Blue sticky trap @ 5-10/acre to monitor the aphids and leaf miner.
