Past Weather for Tamil Nadu District

Weather Summary for the period since the issue of last bulletin 047 (13.06.2023) for Tamil Nadu. Maximum temperature ranged from 34°C to 41°C and minimum temperature ranged from 23°C to 30°C, over the State. Kodaikanal and Uthagamandalam recorded maximum temperature ranged from 20°C to 22°C and minimum temperature ranged from 11°C to13°C. During this period isolated rainfall was recorded in Tamil Nadu.

Coimbatore District Past Weather

In Coimbatore district, during 13.06.23 to 15.06.23 the Maximum temperature was recorded as 34°C and the minimum temperature was 23°C to 24°C. The Morning relative humidity recorded was 77 per cent and evening relative humidity was 60 per cent. The average wind speed recorded was 17-22 km per hour and the wind direction were from South West direction.

		nutrient per tree and don't mix micro nutrient with soil.				
Animal		Do not allow the animals to graze on newly grown grasses, due to the				
		receipt of last week rain.				
		Due to low evening humidity, provide 80-100 liter drinking water to				
		the livestock in four splits.
