Weather Summary/Alert:

Chances of Moderate rain on 10, 12 May & light rain during 11, 13, 14 May. Maximum temperature would be in the range of 34°C to 36°C and the minimum temperature would be between 22°C - 24°C. Cloudy sky will appear for the next five days. Wind expected with the speed of 4-8 Kmph from Southwest & Northwest directions.

General Advisory:

Thunderstorms & lightning with Heavy rain are likely to occur at isolated places over the district on 10thMay 2023. Hence farmers are advised to provide propping in sugarcane and to provide adequate support for crops like Banana, Papaya, Guava and Moringa, to prevent from lodging. For Gourds check the structures /pandhals for damages in the strings and poles and provide adequate support. Provide adequate drainage facilities in the fields to avoid water stagnation due to heavy rainfall. Do not allow the animals to graze outside, standing near the trees, and don't tie the animals to electric poles. Provide safe shelter.

SMS Advisory:

Chances of Moderate rain on 10, 12 May & light rain during 11, 13, 14 May. Max temp 34°C- 36°C & Min temp -22°C- 24°C. Cloudy sky will appear for the next four days. Wind speed 4-8 kmph from SW & NW direc

SAPOTA	The incense of Fruit rot disease is noticed in the Sappotta fruit crop. The symptoms are sunken lesions on the fruit filled with pinkish fungal ooze. To control, spray Camphor solution @ 250ml + Amirtha karaisal @ 250ml with 10 litres of water. Spray 3 times in 12 days intervals. Spraying activities can be carried out only during the non-rainy days.				
CHILLI	Boron deficiency is seen in chilly. The symptoms are malformed leaves found in newly emerging leaves; plants show stunted growth. Chlorotic streaks appear perpendicular to the veins. Incomplete leaf formation and inhibition of fruit and flower would be seen. A deficiency of boron may result in a reduction in the weight and size of the fruit. To reduce the deficiency, foliar spray of 3gm borax per 1 litre of water at 10 days intervals is recommended.
