Weather forecast for next five days (17.05.2023 to 21.05.2023)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Nagapattinam district, the sky will be clear. No rainfall is expected next coming five days. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 38 - 39 °C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 30 - 40 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 80 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 30 - 40 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 8 - 12 km per hour. The wind direction will be south south west.

Rice	Nursery	Rice varieties ADT 36, ADT 43, ADT 45 and ADT 47 are suitable for kuruvai season.				
Rice	Nursery	The seeds should be treated with carbendazim (2 g/kg of seeds) or Pseudomonas (10g/kg of seeds) before sowing.				
Cattle	Cow	As temperature is incensing, spread coconut leaves or paddy straws over the roof of the animal shed and spray cold water to reduce heat stress to the animals.
