Weather forecast for next five days (10.05.2023 to 14.05.2023)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Perambalur district, the sky will be moderately cloudy. Light drizzling is expected on 14.05.2023. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 35 – 37 °C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 28 - 30 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 60 – 70 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 20 - 30 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 4 - 12 km per hour. The wind direction will be south south west.

Crop	Stage	Advisory
General		Do summer ploughing before the expected rainfall to harvest rain water within land.
Rice	Nursery	Rice varieties ADT 36, ADT 43, ADT 45 and ADT 47 are suitable for kuruvai season.
Rice	Nursery	The seeds should be treated with carbendazim (2 g/kg of seeds) or Pseudomonas (10g/kg of seeds) before sowing.
Pulses	Harvest	Protect the harvested crop from expected rainfall.
Cattle	Cow	Protect the cattle from rainfall and keep the cattle shed in dry condition and use disinfectant like lime.

Rice varieties ADT 36, ADT 43, ADT 45 and ADT 47 are suitable for kuruvai season.
