Weather Summary and forecast for Ariyalur district

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Ariyalur district, the sky will be clear. Light drizzling expected on 21.08.2024 and 22.08.2024. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 34 - 36 °C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 23 - 25 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 60 - 80 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 40 - 50 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 16 - 22 km per hour. The wind direction will be south south west.

Cattle	Cow	Since the onset of rainy season may attract mosquitoes breeding, farmers are advised to give Notchi leaves fumigation in dairy barn. Insect population has detrimental effect on milk quality.
