#### Weather Summary and forecast for Thanjavur district

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Thanjavur district, the sky will be clear. Light drizzling expected on 21.08.2024 and 22.08.2024. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 36 - 37 °C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 27 - 28 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 60 - 80 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 40 - 60 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 16 - 24 km per hour. The wind direction will be south south west.

General	Farmers are advised to provide adequate drainage facilities to all crops due to light rainfall forecast.		

		Farmers are requested to download and utilize the agricultural based mobile apps suggested by TNAU (TNAU AAS, Meghdoot and DAMINI).		
Rice	Nursery	Considering favourable weather, prepare nursery for samba crop and make sowing.		
Tucc	Main field	By utilizing weather condition land can be prepared for samba rice cultivation before rain.		
Banana		Provide support with wooden poles to avoid lodging of tree due to wind.		
Cow		Since the onset of rainy season may attract mosquitoes breeding, farmers are advised to give Notchi leaves fumigation in dairy barn.  Insect population has detrimental effect on milk quality.
