Forecast for next five days: 20.07.2024 to 24.07.2024

Dry weather is expected for next five days.

During next five days the sky will be cloudy. The temperature range is expected to be around 27-35°C. Relative humidity range is expected to be around 62-70%. The wind speed is expected to be 15-25 km per hour and the wind will be mostly from west direction.

Rainfall (2.0 mm) will be below normal, maximum temperature (32.0°C) and minimum temperature (23.9°C) will be normal from  $24^{th}$  to  $30^{th}$  July.
