Yesterday's trough from Telangana to central parts of Bay of Bengal now runs from Rayalaseema to central Bay of Bengal across Westcentral Bay of Bengal between 3.1 km & 5.8 km above mean sea level. Conditions are favourable for further advance of Southwest Monsoon into some more parts of Coastal Andhra Pradesh during next 4-5 days.
