Forecast for next five days: 22.01.2025 to 26.01.2025

Moderate rain is expected on 22nd and 23rd January.

Light rain is expected on 24th January.

During next five days the sky will be cloudy. The temperature range is expected to be around 22-29°C. Relative humidity range is expected to be around 80-98 %. The wind speed is expected to be 10-14 km per hour and the wind will be mostly from east north east direction.

Rice	Active tillering	 Drain the excess water from the paddy fields leaving a thin film of water. In paddy fields thinning of tillers may be done and utilized to gap fill the damaged areas. In paddy, after one week of foliar spray top dressing of 50 kg urea and 20 kg potash along with 10 kg of neem cake per hectare may be done. To manage rice leaf folder release <i>Trichogramma chilonis</i> 5cc (1,00,000/ha) at 37, 44, 51 day after planting. Avoid excess application of nitrogen fertilizers. Setup light trap to attract adult moths.Setup T- shaped bird perches for predatory birds to control these pests. Apply cartaphydrochloride 50% SP @ 2g/l or flubendiamide 20 WG @ 0.25 g/l or thiamethoxam 25 WG @ 0.2 g/l.

SMS: Light to moderate rain is expected for next few days. Hence, postpone irrigation to crops.
