ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

The first Veterinary and Animal Sciences University in Asia was established on 20th September 1989 with its head quarters in Chennai with the name Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (popularly abbreviated as TANUVAS) after realizing the importance of education and research in animal and fisheries so as to increase its productivity towards better income generation for the farmers.

TANUVAS has been conferred with the prestigious "Sardar Patel Outstanding ICAR Institution Award-2011", recognizing its outstanding performance in education, research and extension in the country in the field of agricultural sciences including veterinary, animal and fisheries sciences at the 84th Foundation Day celebrations of ICAR on 16.07.2012 at New Delhi. TANUVAS is the first veterinary university in the country to bag this coveted award.

Presently, four veterinary colleges, one food science college, one poultry science college, four research stations, twenty University Training and Research Centres, three farmers training centres and two Avian Disease Diagnostic Laboratories are functioning under this university.

MADRAS VETERINARY COLLEGE

The Madras Veterinary College is located at Vepery, Chennai, India. The college was established on October 1, 1903, in a small building known as Dobbln Hall. The college became affiliated with the University of Madras in 1935, and became the first college to offer the bachelor's degree in Veterinary Medicine in India.



In 1989, the college was affiliated with TANUVAS. At present the college has 27 departments and offers various degree and diploma courses in Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Bioinformatics and Biotechnology.

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The Department was established in the year 1989. It was recognised as a "Centre of Excellence in Veterinary Biotechnology and Immunology" in 1999 by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), New Delhi. The Department of Animal Biotechnology is located at two campuses. Two blocks of three floors each at Madras Veterinary College and Centralised Embryo Biotechnology Unit at Madhavaram campus with "State of art" facilities to carry out research in various facets of Biotechnology. The Department is well equipped with research equipments such as Genetic analyser, Real time PCR, Flow Cytometer, Ultra Centrifuge, Micromanipulator, Bioanalyser and Colour Doppler imaging Ultrasonogram.
